NOTES FROM THE IACS SECRETARIAT

Please note that your most recent paid-up dues year appears on the printed IACS mailing label. As used with this *Newsletter*, these labels reflect payments received up to 30 June 2001. Be sure to keep us informed of any change of address or any change in your membership status.

Dues statements for 2002 will be mailed early in the new year. We are still waiting to see just how the introduction of the new European currency, the euro (EUR), will effect our banking fees. However, it seems clear already that it will be especially helpful if those who must pay in a currency other than the euro (for example, in US dollars), and who must pay by check, will make large payments at less frequent intervals, for example, pay four years' worth of dues every four years. The banking fees on a foreign-currency check for a small amount can add up to 50% or more of the check's value!

THE CHAIR OF COPTIC STUDIES
AT THE AMERICAN UNIVERSITY IN CAIRO

The following is the text of a circular letter from John D. Gerhart, president of the American University in Cairo (AUC), dated June 2001, concerning the professorship of Coptic studies that is being created at his university:

After a wonderful series of dinners and receptions in the spring in Cairo, New York, and Houston, we are nearing our goal for the funds to endow a Chair of Coptic Studies at the American University in Cairo. As of June 26, we have collected some \$625,000 in cash and \$365,186 in pledges toward the one million dollar goal. Before we appoint the professor we will need to receive this \$1 million in cash but while we will continue to seek donations towards the fund, and payment of the outstanding pledges, we have decided to begin the process of selecting a Visiting Professor to fill this distinguished Chair.

I have asked the Dean of Humanities and Social Sciences, Professor Nicholas Hopkins, to appoint a Search Committee to fill this visiting Chair. Dean Hopkins will include the Assistant Provost (a scholar of early Christianity) and the chairs of the Departments of History, Arabic Studies, and the Egyptology unit of the Department of Sociology, Anthropology, Psychology, and Egyptology in this committee. *By copy of this letter, I am inviting all donors to the Chair as well as other scholars in the field to submit nominations for this position.* We will also write to established scholars in the field internationally. The holder of the Chair will have to teach at least one course in his or her field of specialization, but will have

considerable time for research as well. As we indicated previously, it is intended to have a different Visiting Professor each year so that interested students will be able to take a variety of courses over their four-year undergraduate career. By giving adequate advanced notice, we hope also to be able to plan the invitations several years in advance. Nominations should be sent to Dean Nicholas Hopkins at the American University in Cairo, P.O. Box 2511, Cairo, Egypt.

As a by-product of the fund-raising campaign, AUC has been offered the long-term loan of one of the finest private libraries on Coptic Studies in the world. This collection, which runs to some 14,000 items, will eventually be housed in the Rare Books and Special Collections Library on the new campus. It will add immeasurably to the potential for scholarly research in this field and will help us attract leading scholars to the University.

I am grateful to everyone who has helped make this Chair possible, and I look forward to your suggestions for scholars who can fill it.
