

Agreement proposal

between:

PATHs, Sapienza Università di Roma – represented by Prof. Paola Buzi, Director

and

Coptic Scriptorium, represented by Prof. Caroline T. Schroeder (University of Oklahoma) and Prof. Amir Zeldes (Georgetown University)

and

Corpus dei Manoscritti Copti Letterari (CMCL), project of the Unione Accademica Nazionale (Italy), supported by the Union Académique Internationale – represented by Prof. Tito Orlandi, Director.

The above mentioned projects agree about the following points:

1. The three Institutions will collaborate in a joint effort to advance the study of Coptic language and literature, where each of them will especially take care of the following tasks:
 - PATHs: list and stable identification of manuscripts; reconstruction of the codicological units; geographical positioning of the manuscripts with regard to their production, ancient utilization, discovery, and present storage.
 - Scriptorium: public interfaces for linguistic analysis, search, visualization and archiving of Coptic data.
 - CMCL: list, stable identification, and digital encoding of literary pieces.
2. The three Institutions will share the products of their research to be utilized in the respective fields mentioned in point 1. The CMCL will provide digitized texts to be inserted in the interfaces of Coptic Scriptorium. Other exchanges will be negotiated as an operative realization of this agreement.
3. Each Institution remains responsible and master of the products of its research, which may be incorporated in the partners' sites with full attestation of its origin.
4. Each Institution will mention this collaboration in its home page.
5. This agreement is valid for a starting-up period of three years, and will be tacitly renewed every three years, unless one of the Parties withdraws its agreement by means of written statement three months before the expiring date.
6. Materials that have been shared between the projects in the past will remain shared for an unlimited period of time.
