APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Each applicant should submit a proposal covering each of the areas described below. The proposal should be limited to no more than 15 double-spaced pages with one-inch margins and not less than 12 point type. The page limit is independent of the curriculum vitae and letters of reference. **Complete applications must be received by October 31, 2004.**

I. Project proposal.

- A. Cover page: name, institutional affiliation, address, telephone and fax number, email address, and a synopsis of the study including project title, significance, ending and starting dates. (One Page.)
- B. Description of the project.
(Three pages maximum.)
- C. Significance of the project.
(Three pages maximum.)
- D. Research/study procedures.
(Three pages maximum.)
- E. Anticipated publication outlets that will reach the widest possible audience.
(One page.)
- F. Summary of Experience and Qualifications of the researcher.
(Two pages maximum.)
- G. Detailed budget.
(One page.)
- H. Bibliography of related research.
(One page.)
