A NEW MANUSCRIPT IN THE COPTIC MUSEUM (PSALMS, Middle Egyptian or Oxyrhynchite dialect)

(Communication from Dr. Gawdat Gabra, Director of the Coptic Museum, Cairo)

The codex of Psalms (pure Middle Egyptian dialect) had been discovered in Al-muddel-necropolis, on the east bank of the river Nile, about 15/20 kilometres to the south of Beni Suef. It was found in a grave-tomb under the head of a young girl. The cover of the codex was made of wood - like that of the Gospel of Matthew (the Scheide-codex in Princeton, New Jersey).

After some paleographical considerations I am inclined to date the codex to the fifth century. Its folios were stuck together. Only a considerable number of folios at the beginning and end of the quires could be opened. The codex is still in the restoration process. Its folios are about 200 (i.e., 400 pages). A number of the first and last folios are still stuck together with the wooden cover. At least two of the last pages are blank, the folios measure 17 cm. in length and 13 cm. in breadth. The written space in the folio is 13.5 cm. in length and 9 cm. in breadth. Each page contains between 18 and 21 lines. About 75% of the lines contain 18 or 19 letters. About 25% of the lines are written only half way across the page. It could be estimated from the folios which had been treated and restored that 85% of the written text is well-preserved and can be read. Some months ago I had done comparison between the number of folios, lines and letters of our codex and that of the Coptic sahidic book of Psalms published by Budge. One might conclude that our codex must contain the 150 Psalms. This could be confirmed only after the end of the process of restoration. I have already begun to write the facsimile of the folios which had been restored.
