In addition to the published notice concerning the project 'Catalogue Général du Musée Copte' which appear in this Newsletter, No. 20, the Museum Council approved the participation of Dr. Dominique Benzéch (Musée du Louvre) to prepare the section of metals. The application of Dr. Lucy-Anne Hune (The University of Birmingham) to work on the illustrated manuscripts has also been approved. Prof. Dr. Gerald M. Browne (University of Illinois) has written recently offering that also the old Nubian texts might be included in the project.

In accord with permission already granted, the International Photographic Archive of Papyri (UNESCO) has photographed all the Greek and Coptic Papyri of the Coptic Museum.

Brigham Young University under the direction of Prof. Dr.
Kent Brown to microfilm all the Christian Arabic manuscripts
of the Coptic Museum.

In the Sahidic dialect are included important ninth and tenth century codices from Edfu and elsewhere, more White Monastery manuscripts from Akhmim, and papyrus manuscripts from ancient Thebes and Esna; in Bohairic, the manuscripts of Dr John Lee, with the *Marcel Bible*; and in the two dialects, the manuscripts collected by Robert Curzon, 14th Baron Zouche. Three other dialects are also represented.

Prof. Layton has used an up-to-date descriptive method that lends far more precision and detail to his results than any previous catalogue of Coptic manuscripts. Inspired by recent advances in bibliographic science, papyrology, and codicology, this catalogue is one of the most exact descriptions of an Oriental Christian manuscript collection that has ever been undertaken. 297 items are described, accompanied by an essay on the history of the manuscripts, an account of the descriptive method, 14 indexes, and a section of plates containing 307 paleo-graphic samples.
